Goes Through the Senate by a Vote of 50 to 3.

## ALSO THE CANAL **AMENDMENT**

Canal Rider the Bone of Fiercest Contention - Session Lasted Eight Hours - Silver Republicans and Democratic Senators Make a Vigorous Attack, But All to No Avail.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 26 .- By a vote of fifty to three the senate, after a session which lasted nearly eight hours, passed the river and harbor bill, with the Nicaragua canal amendment. A determined fight was made on committee amendments, but in each instance opposition was defeated.

The sharpest contest arose over the Nicaragua canal bill amendment. A point of order was made against it that it was general legislation, but the senate, to which the vice president submitted the point, overruled it. It was then attacked as not being relevant to a river and harbor measure, but this, too, was overruled by the senate. Pettigrew, Silver Republican, of South Dakota; Rawlins, Democrat, of Utah, and Teller, ing directed especially against the canal amendment. The statement was made that the measure would never see the light of day in the house, and that the canal would not be built under the proposition inserted in the bill.

Sewell, Republican, of New Jersey, delivered a speech in support of the Hull-Hawley army reorganization bill, in the course of which he declared that the United States was now as much at war in the Philippines as it was with Spain The busiest and mightiest little thing when our army was before Santiago.
