Roosevelt Describes the Character and Kind of Men He Commanded.

Then I went down to San Antonia myself, where I found the men from New Mexico, Arizona and Oklahoma already gathered, while those from Indian territory came in soon after my

These were the men who made up the bulk of the regiment, and give it its peculiar character. They came from the four territories which yet remain within the boundaries of the United States; that is, from the lands that have been most recently won over to white civilization, and in which the conditions of life are nearest those that obtained on the frontier when there still was a frontier. They were a splendid set of men, these southwesterners-tall and sinewy, with resolute, weatherbeaten faces, and eyes that looked a man straight in the face without flinching.
