SUGAR AND SEA POWER.

From This Showing Each of the Great Maritime Nations Has n Sweet Tooth.

The great maritime powers are all great sugar-eating nations. Wherever the spirit of navigation, commerce, travel and colonization is strong there is a large consumption of sugar per head, says Pearson's Weekly.

England heads the nations of the world in fondness for sweet things, the sugar consumption there being 70 ounds a year for each inhabitant. The inited States is a close second, each individual consuming 67.07 pounds per an-

In Denmark the quantity is 45 pounds bead, in Holland 34 pounds, in France 20 pounds, in Norway and Sweden 25 pounds, in Russia 10 pounds, in Italy 7 pounds, in Turkey 7 pounds, in Greece pounds and in Servia 4 pounds.

Cuba produces annually 975,000 tons of cane sugar, the United States 300,000 tons. Java contributes 480,000 tons each year, the Philippine islands 265,000 tons, Hawaii 135,000 tons and Porto Rico 60,-(00 tons.

Germany leads in the production of beetsugar, with one-third of the annual yield, while Austria is next. France, Russia, Belgium and Holland each produce about the same quantity.
