VILLAINOUS VINO'S VIMLESS VICTIMS

Many Soldiers at Manila Incapacitated by Bad Liquor.

MENACE IS A SERIOUS ONE

Officers Give the Question Careful Consideration With a View to Devising Plans to Abate the Evil.

NEW YORK, April 18 .- A special to the Tribune from Washington says: Among the serious problems confronting General Otis at Manila none has caused greater anxiety than the alarming effects produced upon the American soldiers, particularly the enlisted men, by a eeductive beverage which they procured in native shops and which produced A such physical and mental demoralization as to give rise to a suspicion that the army of occupation was being systematically drugged or poisoned to render it helpless to resist an insurgent attack.

COLFAX, Wash., April 17 .- The 3-yearold daughter of George Tempero, a farmer living near Kamiac butte, fifteen miles east of Colfax, was burned to death with a lighted lamp. A few minutes later a scream from the bouse attracted their attention. The child was found with its clothing afire from the overturned lamp. It died from its injuries within an hour.

What the Filipinos Will Ask.

New York, April 18 .- A dispatch to the Herald from Manila says: In an interview with General Lagarda, he said that a committee of twenty-two Filipinos had been appointed to confer with the peace commission for the following purposes:

First-To obtain as large autonomous rights for the Filipino people as possible. Second-To bring about peaceful relations between the insurgents and the

Third-That the Americans and Filipinos shall occupy public offices.

Arevaleo, a former aide to Aguinaldo, is now in Manila. He said in an interview that if the Americans send to Aguina'do now he thinks a peaceful solution of the present troubles is probable.
