The Aurora, which was one of the yellowest of the Jeffersonian papers, said, in its edition of March 11, 1801, describing the mauguration ceremonies, that "at an early hour on Wednesday, March 4, the City of Washington presented a spectacle of uncommon animation;" that "at 12 o'clock Thomas Jefferson, attended by a number of his fellow citizens, among whom were many members of congress, repaired to the capitol;" that "he entered the capitol under a discharge of artillery" and that "as soon as he withdrew a discharge of artillery was made."






