Drastic measures are being taken by the state officials of Idaho, under cover of martial law, to settle on a to the Wardner mining district for the preservation of life and property, kays the Oregonian. The plan, Driefly, is to purge the district, and thereby the state of Idaho, of the lawless element that has long been in control of the Miners' Association. In justice, therefore, to all concerned-the men who own the mills, the men whose capital is their labor, the local authorities, charged with the duty of keeping the peace and the federal authorities that have twice been levied upon at great ex-




