Behool District No. 5 of Waseo County, Oregon, will issue two coupon bonds of the par value of lour hundred dollars each bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, interest payable semi-annually; said bonds being redeemable at the pleasure of said district-after ten years from their date, but due and payable absolutely twenty years from date. 
