GENERAL OTIS CALLED A HALT

But His Forces are Ready to Resume Fighting Instantly.

ARMISTICE NOT AGREED TO

Threatened Attack of Iloilo by Rebels Failed to Come Off—Movement of Koppé's Expedition.

MANILA, May 20.—Major-General Otis has declined to recognize the rebels to the extent of agreeing to an armistice, but he has notified the American commanders to refrain temporarily from aggressive action.

The Filipinos are so deceptive that the people hesitate to credit with good faith their latest overtures. But more attention is now paid to them than to their previous advances.

Senor Gonzaga carries instructions from Aguinaldo, which, he states, if accepted by General Otis, empower them to conclude peace.

The Filipino commissioners called on Major-General Otis this afternoon and arranged to meet the members of the American commission Monday.

At Iloilo an attack on the Americans was expected. The Filipino leader boasted that he had 1500 riflemen and 10,000 bolo men.
