Early Literature of Oregon.

The second lecture which the members of the Taine class have provided for the people of The Dalles occurred last evening at the Congregational church. Mr. Geo. H. Himes, of Portland, secretary of the Oregon Historical Association, was the speaker of the evening and read an interesting paper upon "The Early Literature of Oregon." Mr. W. H. Wilson introduced the speaker with a few comments upon the desirability of the inhabitants of this state becoming acquainted with its early history, and stated in this connection that knowledge should begin at home. Mr. Himes' paper began with the first mention of Oregon in literature, which occurred in the writings of Jonathan Carver about the middle of the 17th century. From that time until recent years the increasing mention of the great Northwest in the writings of the world was traced with much detail and told in an exceedingly interesting manner. The first printing press ever in the Pacific Northwest was brought from the Sandwich Islands early in the thirties and used to print the first copies of the early Oregon papers. This press, Mr. Himes stated, was now in his office in Portland. The lecture was well attended, and those who were present felt under much obligation to Mr. Himes for his interesting researches and to the Taine class for providing such an interesting occasion.

To Test Her Speed.

All records for fast time on the river are in danger of being smashed into smithereens before another forty eight hours have elapsed. Tomorrow morning the D. P. & A. N. Co.'s new steamer Inland Flyer will go out for a test of

speed, and there will be nothing undone to attain the desired results. If possible the razor-like craft will be made to fairly fly over her course. Mr. Glenn, president of the company, came down from The Dalles this morning, and is helping out in arranging for the trial. He states the Flyer is expected to leave the foot of Oak street, the company's wharf, at 10 o'clock, and it is possible that the run will extend as far as Rainier. General Agent W. C. Alloway will arrive in the city this afternoon from The Dalles, and will, in company with a number of local steamboat men, go along on the trial trip.

Captain Alden, who is to be master of the Flyer when going into regular commission, will be at the wheel tomorrow.—Telegram.
