Conditions have been growing rapidly worse in this respect, and three miners who have just reached here from that country say that the pitiful scenes enacted among the starving Indian beggars description. They are now almost entirely without perishing in great numbers. So hopeless is the situation, that in a single small Indian village no less than thirty persons died from hunger just previous to the departure of the prospectors for this port. The miners who are authority for these statements declare that unless abundant supplies are immediately dispatched to the relief of these famishing and despondent people, their practical Terrible Ending of a Bridal Serenade. extermination is inevitable.
