

NEW RICHMOND, Wis., June 14 .- No bodies were recovered from the tornado ruins last night, The work is being abandoned on account of a heavy rain and exhaustion of the working parties. It is expected the task of looking for the dead will proceed with greater success than yesterday. The number still in the ruins is variously estimated from 50 to 100.


