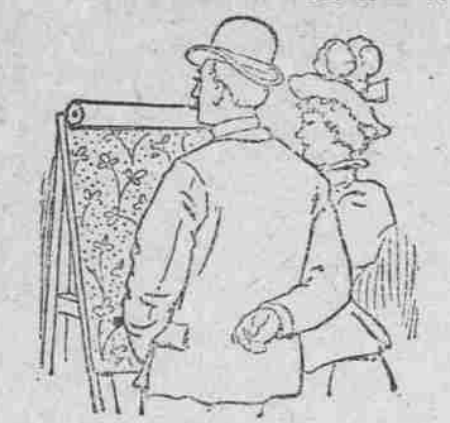

- 1 gallon 25c a day, two gallons or more a day 20c per gallon.

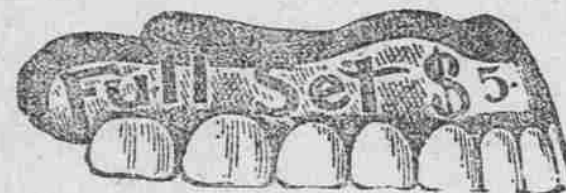

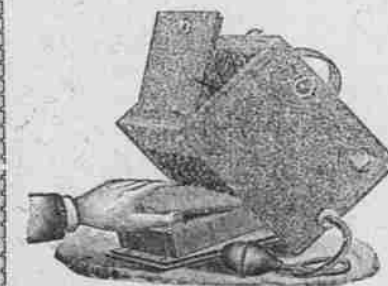
