Supposed Beneficial Law May Work Them Injury.

EMPLOYMENT IS JEAPORDED

sale July 1-And Men Put in Their Places-Law Requires That Employers Shall Not Permit Women to Work Over a Limited Number of Hours Per Day.

CHICAGO, June 20 .- A special to the Times-Herald from Omaha says: Female employes in the large mercantile establishments and factories in Omaha are in a condition of unrest. They do not know whether they will hold their present positions after July 1, and if they are discharged they do not know whether they can find another place in which to work. What is true of the women workers of regret it. Omaha is true of other large cities in the state. This condition of unrest is due to the law regulating the employment of legislature, and which becomes operative relief and in the end the stomach trouble triend advised 'Electric Bitters'; and to July 1. The provisions of the law are peculiar. It regulates and limits the hours of employment of females in manufacturing, mechanical and mercantile establishments, hotels and restaurants. Every employer is compelled to provide suitable seats for the female employes and permit the women to use them. It fixes a penalty of \$50 for every infraction and makes it the duty of the deputy labor commission to see that the law is proper-

women employed in many Omahs stores will be permitted to begin work about 10 o'clock Saturdays in order that they may remain late in the evening of that date, without laying their employers liable to fine. The proprietor of one of the largest department stores in the city said that he did not think the law would cause the dismissal of a large number of women in his establishment, for the present, at least. His firm will obey the law strictly, and if its observance shall suggest economy in the weeding out process, that matter would be taken up
