There is a disposition among conservative statisticians to avoid high figures in the forecasts of the probable population which will be found in the country a year hence. There are, of course, two causes for this. The financial convulsion of 1893, checked immigration, and probably cut down the natural increase from the inside. Keeping these two considerations in mind, however, there is no good reason to suppose that the aggregate Inhabitants in 1900 will be below the 75,000,000 This figure, indeed, will represent a very encouraging growth. 


