Death of Judge Martin.

PENDLETON, Or, June 25 .- County Judge William Martin, died at 9:30 this morning. He was elected county judge in 1888, and, had he lived until next year, would have served 12 years in that office. He had been sheriff of this county three terms, sheriff of Siskiyon county, California, and mayor of Pendleton. He was one of the early pioneers, and had, besides the title of judge, that of captain, which he earned in the Indian wars. Judge Martin was 77 years old, and had always had good health up to June 15, when he suffered from a apoplectic stroke.
