The correspondent says that trusts exist in nearly every country in Europe, and are quite common in England. There are over 200 in Germany, as enumerated in the newspapers of that country.

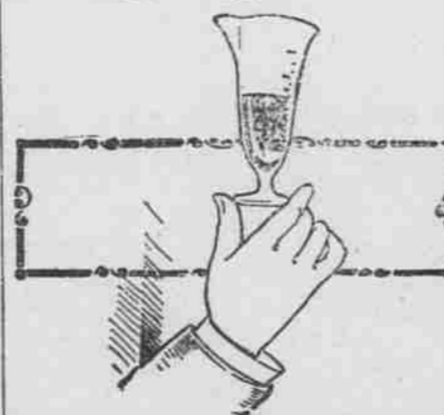

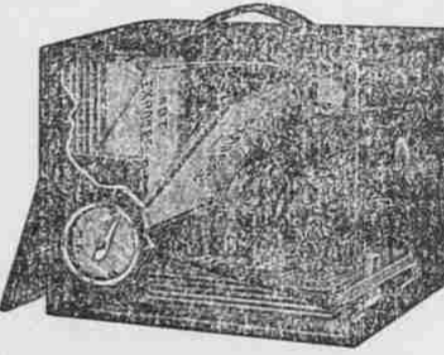
