BURIED FOR THE TIME.

It is very gratifying to hear that the navy department is going to take no further official notice of the controversy over the merits of Rear Admirals Schley and Sampson, says the Spokesman Review. If people generally will do the same in a private capacity, a good deal of valuable time can be devoted to more useful purposes and newspaper space will be utilized for more attractive advertising.

There is invariably a disposition to give credit where it is due, but when people have settled the matter to their own individual satisfaction, they are willing to let it rest. The late war is certain to be talked over for a good many years and there will be differences of opinion as to who was especially conspicuous for gallantry and as to what ought to have been done which was not done. Disputes will arise similar to those heated but bloodless pen combats which followed the publication of the civil war articles a few years ago in a popular monthly magazine.

But so long as we were victorious, it is the wiser course to talk only of the pleasanter features of our campaigns on land and sea. As for all these personal squabbles, let the principals settle them ten or fifteen years hence when they have nothing else to do and the public is not surfeited with military and naval bickerings which amount to nothing.

PARTISAN OPPOSITION.

Opposition to the administration in its Philippine policy and its conduct of the war on mere partisan grounds is likely to be overdone by some of the Democratic leaders. A large portion of politicians—and nearly all Americans are politicians—are simply "agin" any administration of the opposing party, and everything it does, good or bad, right or wrong—and oppose it when it is right and does well just as strenuously as in the other event. Whatever it does they are bound to condemn. A great many of those who are now severest in their criticism of the president for prosecuting the war were the loudest in demanding back and tried to keep out of war, they were for war, right off and red hot; but as soon as the country began war, and while it is necessarily continuing war, they affect a righteous indignation at all that is being done. If the administration had abandoned the Philippines, they would have howled against that policy even more loudly than they do now against the policy of keeping them. So with anything, everything; they are simply "agin" McKinley because he is not of their party.

These chronic and hidebound partisan kickers are in a small minority, however, as they will discover after the votes are counted next year. But such men never learn anything,

not even by being thoroughly whipped.—Evening Telegram.

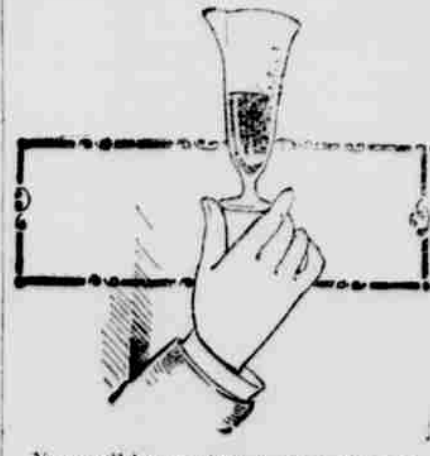
