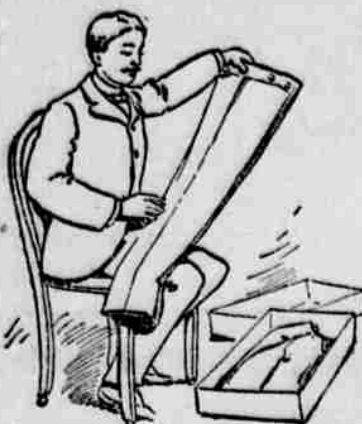

NEW CABLES.

It was announced recently that the British steamer Egeria had arrived at Esquimalt to survey the route for the British Columbia and Australia cable. The work will be hastened and cable laying begin in the very near future, so that within a few years there will be direct telegraphic communication across the Pacific.

The Americans are also active in working up a trans-Pacific cable project. It is proposed to connect San Francisco with the Philippines. The British route is from Esquimalt to Honolulu and thence to Apia and Australia. The American line will run from San Francisco to the Hawaiian islands, thence to Wake and Guam, thence to Samar, and from that point to the Philippines. Another line is projected from some American port to the Aleutian islands and thence to Japan. These new cable lines have been talked of for years, and it is only a matter of a comparatively short time before some of them are in operation.

New Atlantic cables are also being constructed. The German-American line will be ready for business in a few months. This will give the United States direct communication with Germany and France. It is something that is needed, for the service now is inadequate to the growing demands of trade.

The service with South America will also be improved in the near future. At present it is very slow and inefficient, and the rates charged are almost prohibitive. The president thought the matter of sufficient importance to call the attention of congress to it in his last message and he suggested that the various nations interested ought to come to some suitable agreement in regard to the reduction of rates, possibly through international ownership.—Spokesman-Review.

Hoke Smith, editor of the Atlanta Journal, favors discontinuance of the war in the Philippines and the retirement of our troops from the islands. He says he hopes and believes our arms will fail, and he declares that the South is opposed to continuance of the war. On the other hand, Clark Howell, editor of the Atlanta Constitution, says that there are a great many people in the South who believe in standing by the administration in circumstances like those at present shaping our policy, and that the South is particularly interested in upholding the government in Cuba. Mr. Howell says further that the Democratic party should be cautious in its utterance on this subject. Travelers through the Southern states say they

have found the expansion sentiment so strong as to indicate a disposition to break up party lines if the race problem could be set aside. Hoke Smith will be remembered as one of the secretaries in Cleveland's cabinet. He passes for a "mugwump."—Oregonian.

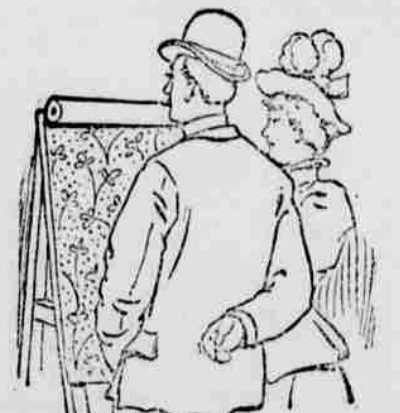

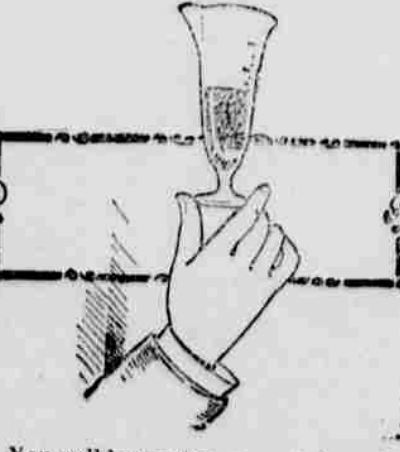
