NEW CABLES.

It was announced recently that the British steamer Egeria had arrived at Esquimalt to survey the route for the British Columbia and Australia cable. The work will be hastened and cable laying begin in the very near future, so that within a few years there will be direct telegraphic communication across the Pacific.

The Americans are also active in working up a trans-Pacific cable project. It is proposed to connect San Francisco with the Philippines. The British route is from Esquimalt to Honolulu and thence to Apia and Australia. The American line will run from San Francisco to the Hawaiian islands, thence to Wake and Guam, thence to Semar, and from that point to the Philippines. Another line is projected from some American port to the Aleutian islands and thence to Japan. These new cable lines have been talked of for years, and it is only a matter of a comparatively short time before some of them are in operation.
