SHOULD TAKE ITS HANDS OFF.

Mr. Hill, our consul at Santos, reports to the department of state that "the United States should adopt the agencies adopted by European nations in attaining their supremacy in these markets, viz., steamships under our own flag, banks under our own control and business houses under distinctively American management." This is a sample of the paternal school of trade. But Mr. Hill's own report sets forth that "exports to Brazil have fallen off since 1893 from every one of the principal countries, with the single exception of the United States. The reduction is as follows: Great Britain, 18.5 per cent; France, 28.6; Hamburg, 21.2; Belgium, 53.5; Argentine Republic, 11.1; Uruguay, 17.8, and Portugal, 16.7 per cent. The only increase was that of 13.4 per cent for the United States." Mr. Hill, or rather the report in the Brazilian Review, which he incorporates into his report, shows that the coffee exports varied little from 70 per cent of the imports; from 1894 to 1898 the coffee exports declined from \$24,000,000 to \$14,000,000, and the imports had to fall off in about the same ratio. If our exports to Brazil increased in a period within which our reciprocity treaty was abrogated, and during which Brazil's exports declined and her imports from all European countries, and even her South American neighbors, declined, the importance of imitating European methods of pushing our trade there is not very clear. Government aid of commerce is a delusive object of pursuit. Trade is won by energy, skill and patience. What the commercial world should strive for is to get government to take its hands off the business its interference is crippling.—Oregonian.

The suggestion has been repeatedly made by the North American that the true way of arriving at compulsory arbitration as a substitute for strikes and lockouts is to impose upon corporations, as a condition of their creation by the state, the obligation to settle disputes with employees by an appeal to an impartial tribunal. Eminent lawyers declare the proposal legally sound, and men interested in social progress regard it as an extremely fruitful idea. Naturally, the violent disturbances in Brooklyn and Cleveland, and the prevalence of less warlike strikes elsewhere, cause everybody just now to be more than usually hospitable to plans for a remedy.
