COLUMBIA RIVER BOUNDARY.

The commission which was authorized by the states of Oregon and Washington to determine the state boundary has commenced its labors, says the Review. "The matter which it has to determine and report upon to the legislatures of the two states is an important one and should have been settled long ago. While the Columbia river is supposed to separate Oregon and Washington at least from Wallula west, the exact line of demarkation has never been laid down or definitely agreed upon.

"This lack of a definite boundary has resulted in many complications as to the rights, titles and interests in tide lands, and a great deal of litigation would be inevitable so long as the matter remains unadjusted. The question of police jurisdiction has been one sadly involved for many years. The fishing industry has grown to enormous proportions and the opportunities for a clash of authorities have increased with time. There have been differences as to the territorial extent of the authority of the fish commissioners from each state, and out of these have grown conflicts as to collecting licenses and the general enforcement of fishing laws which the two states have never been able to make uniform.

"The settlement of the exact boundary line will so clear up matters as to prevent many troubles arising in the future. The Columbia has for years been an outlet for Oregon people and Oregon produce. Its river transportation lines were originally Oregon corporations. The early cannery men were from Oregon and their business is now done with the Oregon metropolis. Oregon, therefore, has not unnaturally regarded the Columbia as an Oregon river. As a matter of fact it is not. It is half Oregon and half Washington and it ought to be determined where the boundary line is before the Oregonians get the idea deep rooted that by lapse of time they have acquired an easement over the entire stream."

Who ever thought of the Columbia belonging to any one but Oregonians. We didn't. We even speak of it as the "Oregon."

Nothing is given out concerning the relations between the O. R. & N. and the Northern Pacific, says the Oregonian. Both parties maintain silence, and a great deal of it. One thing, however, is certain: The O. R. & N. will build a line into the Nez Perces country. Whether the Northern Pacific will build down the Columbia, or whether there will be trackage arrangements, whether, in short, there is to be war or peace, is a secret that must await developments. So great an issue is not likely to be settled in a day. But what we do know is that the Oregon road will not give up any part of its

position in the Columbia basin. Hence it will build into the Nez Perces country.

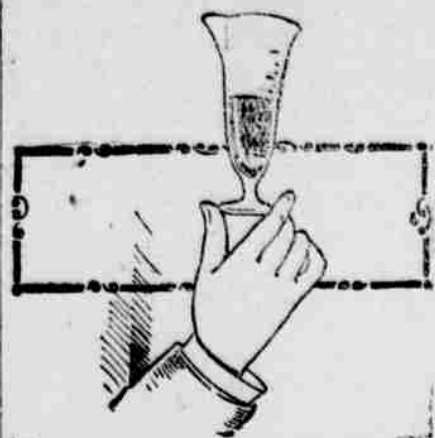

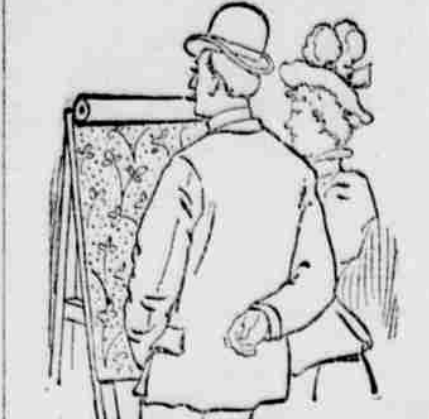

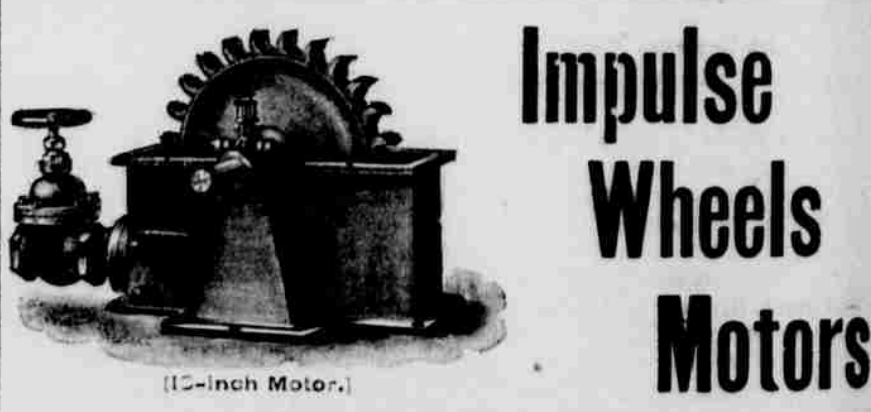
