COLUMBIA RIVER BOUNDARY.

The commission which was authoruzed by the states of Oregon and Washington to determine the state boundary has commenced its labors, FRENCH & CO., says the Review. "The matter which it has to determine and report upon to the legislatures of the two states is TRANSACTA ENERAL BANKING BUSINES an important one and should have been settled long ago. "The settlement of the exact bound ary line will so clear up matters as to prevent many troubles arising in the future. The Columbia has for years been an outlet for Oregon people and Oregon produce. Its river transportation lines were originally Oregon corporations. The early cannery men were from Oregon and their business is now done with the Oregon metropolis. Oregon, therefore, has not unnaturally regarded the Columbia as an Oregon river. As a matter of fact it is not. It is half Oregon and half Washington and it ought to be determined where the boundary line is before the Oregonians get the idea deep Sisters of the Holy Name of rooted that by lapse of time they h :ve acquired an easement over the entire stream."






