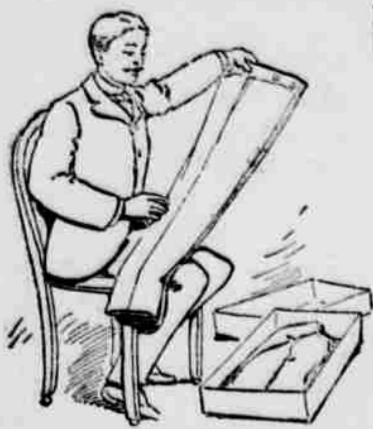

The Iowa Democrats and Populists are fused. They endorse in toto and in detail, and swallow, hoof and hides, jointly and severally, the Chicago platform, and they view with alarm in common the trusts and imperialism. Under the circumstances fusion is proper. It is all Bryanism, and this means the same things, whether going under the Democratic or Populist label.

The year 1899 has been an unusual one, and worrying to farmers and fruit growers generally. But, on the whole, it will no doubt go out with many things to its credit. And 1900 will be a banner year, with favorite weather conditions. The rest which many fruit trees and many acres of land have had will put them in shape to produce more abundantly in the future. We have no such thing as a failure of crops. We have a vast number of blessings to be thankful for.

Last year there were five widows of revolutionary soldiers on the pension rolls. One, Nancy Jones, has just died in Tennessee. She was about 90 years old, and married Darling Jones, who fought at King's Mountain, S. C., when she was 16 and he was over 60. This would indicate that Jones was about 20 years old at the close of the revolution, and that he married the young girl about 1825. Thus it comes about that the government is paying revolutionary pensions more than 115 years after the close of the war. The government paid well for Jones' services in behalf of independence.

Mercier is the man who originally pronounced Dreyfus guilty three weeks before trial. At one time he was thought to be in doubt, but pressure was brought to bear upon him and he became a fierce anti-Dreyfusite soon after Rochefort wrote this about him: "A person named Mercier, a general by trade and minister of war in consequence of circumstances independent of his will, should, several days ago, have been taken by the scruff of his neck and thrown, with the utmost violence, down the stairs of his department, because, after having refused to order the arrest of the traitor Dreyfus, he only decided to do it under the menace of a scandal which the honest colleagues of the said Dreyfus were resolved to stir up."

Crank politics will lose a persistent representative in Iowa when General James B. Weaver passes on and out. No convention flying the "reform" banner would be complete without the presence of this veteran idealist in politics, says the Oregonian. It matters not whether the legend upon this banner has been greenbacks,

prohibition, populism, free silver or a fusion of one or more of these ideas with Jeffersonian Democracy. General Weaver has trained under it industriously and with great volubility in platform utterance for more than a generation. A mouthpiece in all conventions called to represent the isms and schisms of crank politics in his state, General Weaver is outside of this specialty a genial old gentleman, with an honorable record as a soldier and private citizen. Since in his favorite role he is perfectly harmless, no one has any quarrel with him, though it must be admitted that his political and platform platitudes have at times the effect of "a thrice-told tale, vexing the dull ears of a drowsy man."

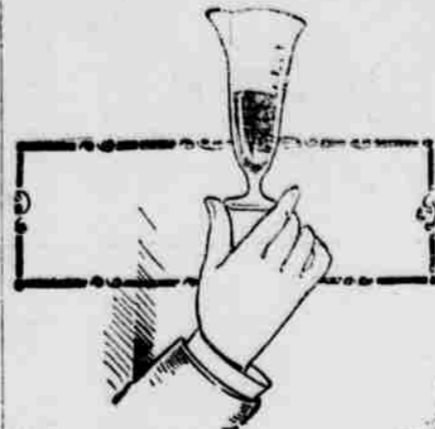

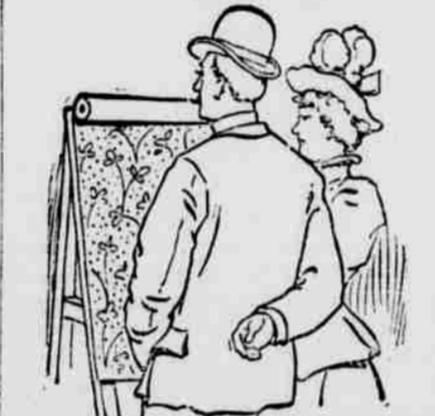
