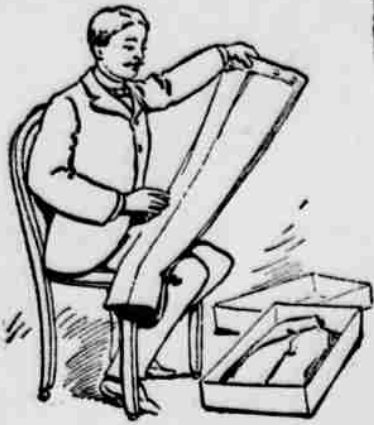

### PEACE IS WANTED.

What is wanted in the Philippines first is peace, and, after pacification, the introduction of good government which shall insure protection for life and property and civic and religious liberty under the American flag, says the Review.

The government has given an object lesson of the futility of attempting the establishment of local economy before the Tagal revolt has been wiped out by force of arms. The mayors of Baling and San Pedro have been found aiding the recruiting service of Aguinaldo. These mayors, of course, are regarded by sympathetic Americans as heroes, but the fact that such officials have proven treacherous shows that it will be better to defer the settling up of municipal governments under native auspices until all organized revolt in Luzon is annihilated.

General Otis has permitted thousands of self-styled friends to come within our lines and even into Manila, where they secretly obtain supplies and play the part of spies for the Katapunan secret organization, and make their living at our expense. War is war, and war it is in Luzon, and the tide of pretended friends must be turned back where they belong. They have been a serious hindrance to our operations afield. The white flag to the Tagalos is only a shield to their treachery and duplicity and in many cases of their murderous intentions.

Our government is now responsible for order and security to life and property in the archipelago and it is in duty bound, nationally and internationally, to crush all opposition to such order and security. The opponents of the purposes of the United States are, beyond question, the worst enemies the natives of Luzon have. Aguinaldo and his sympathizers in this country are doing their best to prevent the natives from realizing their desire for civil and religious liberty and absolute order and security for life and property, which will surely follow the peaceful exercise of the United States sovereignty. It is an outrageous travesty on patriotism for any American to pretend to believe that the United States is pursuing a cruel course of bloody tyranny in the Philippines.

### AWAY OFF.

The Democrats will not nominate William J. Bryan for president next year for two reasons, viz: First, they couldn't come within sight of an election with him as their candidate; and, second, he represents no vital Democratic principles.—Philadelphia Times.

Don't you fool yourself. The first

reason cuts no figure with the Democratic party. Secondly, he represents all the vital Democratic principles—or at least the vital principles set forth time after time by the members of that party who have held the power—beginning with the national convention at Chicago in 1896.

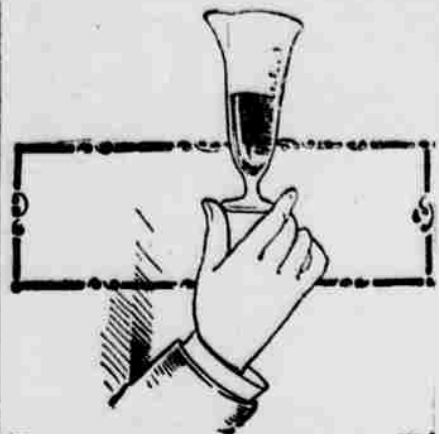

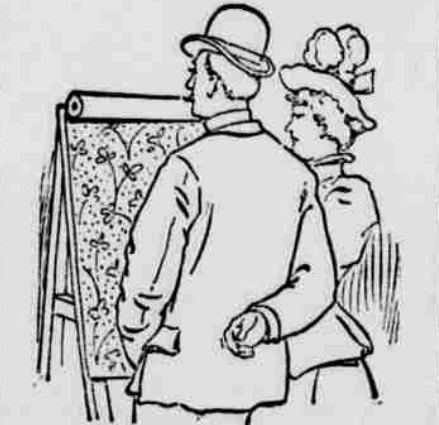

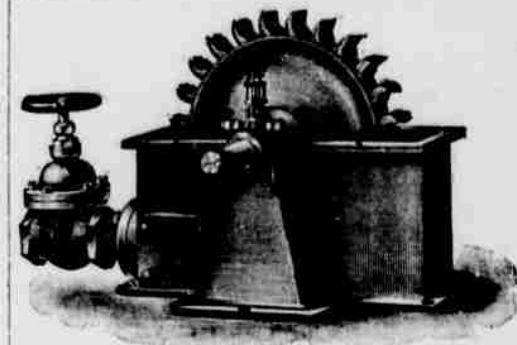
