James B. Eustis, who died Saturday, was a man of more than ave whole a distinguishel one. He was southern born, but attended the Harfter his graduation begen ge in New Orleans. His public practice ver aftermard. He was a member of the legislature during reconstruction and was one of the committee sent to Washington to gard to the vexed problems arising out of reconstruction. He also served in the state senate and in 1876 was plected to the United States senate.
He was not seated till 1877 and erved only two years. In 1884, however, he was elected for and served a full term. For the greater part of his senatorial career he was a of foreign affairs.
While in the senate Mr. Eustis wos not in cordial sympathy with Mr. Cleveland during the latter's first term. The senator from Louisiana civil service ideas, and while he wis in the senate be could hardly be called a supporter of the executive. and one of $\mathrm{M}_{\mathrm{r}}$. Cleveland's first appointments after hissecond inauguration was that of Mr. Eustis as our representalive to France. He was well fitted for the place.
