

JAMES B. EUSTIS.

James B. Eustis, who died Saturday, was a man of more than average ability and his career was on the whole a distinguished one. He was southern born, but attended the Harvard law school at Cambridge and after his graduation began practice in New Orleans. His public life was ever afterward as a servant of the state of Louisiana until his appointment to the embassy at Paris.
