The Spokesman-Review says: In this connection it is interesting to
recall the remarkatle prediction made in the early part of the century by the noted agriculturist and mathematician, Elkanah Watson. By general averages, Mr. Watson computed the population of the country for successive decades for nearly century athead with an accuracy that is almost astounding. His calculathe actual count proved to be for five succeeding decades. Only in 100,000 out of the way, and his cal culations had been made before 1820.

enumeration. He predicted 76,000 , enumeration.
