LONDON, Oct. 31 .- While minor reverses were not wholly unexpected, nothing like the staggering blow General Joubert delivered to General White's force yesterday was anticipated. The full extent of the disaster is not yet acknowledged, if it is known, at the war office. The loss, in effect, must be appalling to General White, who is practically surrounded. Two of the finest British regiments and a mule battery deducted from Ladysmith garrison, weakens it about a fifth of its total strength and alters the whole situation fighters and military strategists of no mean order.

This disaster cost the British 1500 to 2000 men and six seven-pound screw guns, and as the Boer artillery is already stronger than imagined, the capture of these guns will be a great help to the Boers. Further news must be waited before it is attempted to fix the blame where it belongs. White manfally accepted all responsibility for the disaster, which was at least partly due to the scampering of mules with the guns.


