Opposed to Woman's Suffrage.
A society called the Oregon State Association Opposed to the Extension of the Suffrage to Women has been organized in Portland, and numbers among its members some of the most prominent ladies of the city. A circular sent out to the voters of Oregon, says in part: "We desire to call your attention to the fact that an amendment to the constitution of Oregon, giving full suffrage to every adult woman in the state, is to be submitted to your vote in June, 1900. We, being Oregon women, and therefore effected by the provisions of such an amendment, wish to enter our protest against its adoption by you." "We believe only a small percentage of the women of our state ask for or desire the ballot. Our school elections prove, as do those of every state in the Union which permits women to vote at such elections, that the great majority of Oregon women do not use the ballot even in school matters, in which they may be presumed to take equal interest on account of their children." "We believe the majority should rule in this, as in other political matters, and that a small, though eager minority of our sex should not force the ballot (and

its attendant privileges of sitting on juries and running for office) upon the far larger number of women who do not desire to vote. We have no quarrel with our suffragist sisters; but we protest against their being regarded as representatives of the true opinion of Oregon women upon this vital subject.
