

He has become an important factor in railroad building, in the construction of telegraph lines, and the agents of great supply houses have streamed into the sections where the bulk of our exports find ready admission. So strong has been the influence of American foothold in the Orient that no commercial treaty will be formed between Pekin and European capitals without the knowledge and cognizance of the Washington government.






