Geer, Gov-ernor of the State of Oregon, do hereby cause the following proposed amendments to the Consti-tution of the State of Oregon, as certified to by the Secretary of State, to be published for five consecutive weeks in THE DALLES CHRONICLE, a newspaper published in the South Judicial District of the State of Oregon. SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION, NO. 4.

Be it resolved by the Senaté, the House con-curring: That the following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oregon be and is eurring.

ARTICLE XL.

ARTICLE XI. Section 10. No county, city, town, school dis-trict or other municipal corporation shall be al-lowed to become indebted in any manner or for any purpose to an amount including present ex-isting indebtedness in the aggregate exceeding five per centum on the value of the taxable property therein to be ascertained by the last as-sessment for State and county taxes previous to the incurting of such indebtedness.




SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION, NO. 13.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House con-curring: That the following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oregon, in licu of Section Ten of Article Seven (7), be and the same is hereby proposed, to wit:

SECTION TEN. The Legislative Assembly may provide for the election of Supreme and chruit Judges in dis-tinct classes, one of which classes shall consist of five Justices of the supreme Court, who shall not perform circuit duty; and the other class shall consest of as many Circuit Judges as may be deemed necessary, who shall hold full terms without allotment and who shall take the same out as the Supreme Judges. oath as the Supreme Judges.
