STATE OF OREGON. EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT. SALEM, Nov. 21, 1899. In accordance with the provisions of an Act entitled "An Act submitting to the Electors of the State of Oregon the general election to be held on the first Monday in June, 1900, the proposed amendments to the Constitution, approved February 18, 1899, I, T. T. Geer, Governor of the State of Oregon, do hereby certify the following proposed amendments to the Constitution of the State of Oregon, as certified to by the Secretary of State, to be published for five consecutive weeks in THE DALLES CHRONICLE, a newspaper published in the seventh Judicial District of the State of Oregon.

Done at the Capitol, at Salem, Oregon, [SEAL] this 21st day of November, A. D. 1899. T. T. GEER, Governor.

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4. Be it resolved by the Senate, the House concurring: That the following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oregon be and is hereby proposed.

SECTION XI. No county, city, town, school district or other municipal corporation shall be allowed to become indebted in any manner or for any purpose to an amount exceeding the existing indebtedness in the aggregate exceeding five per centum of the value of the taxable property therein to be ascertained by the last assessment for State and county taxes previous to the incurring of such indebtedness.

SECTION TEN. The Legislative Assembly may provide for the election of supreme and circuit judges in distinct classes, one of which classes shall consist of five justices of the supreme court, who shall not perform circuit duty, and the other class shall consist of as many circuit judges as may be deemed necessary, who shall hold full terms without allotment and who shall take the same oath as the supreme judges.

SECTION NINE. The Legislative Assembly may create as many circuit judges as may be deemed necessary, who shall hold full terms without allotment and who shall take the same oath as the supreme judges.

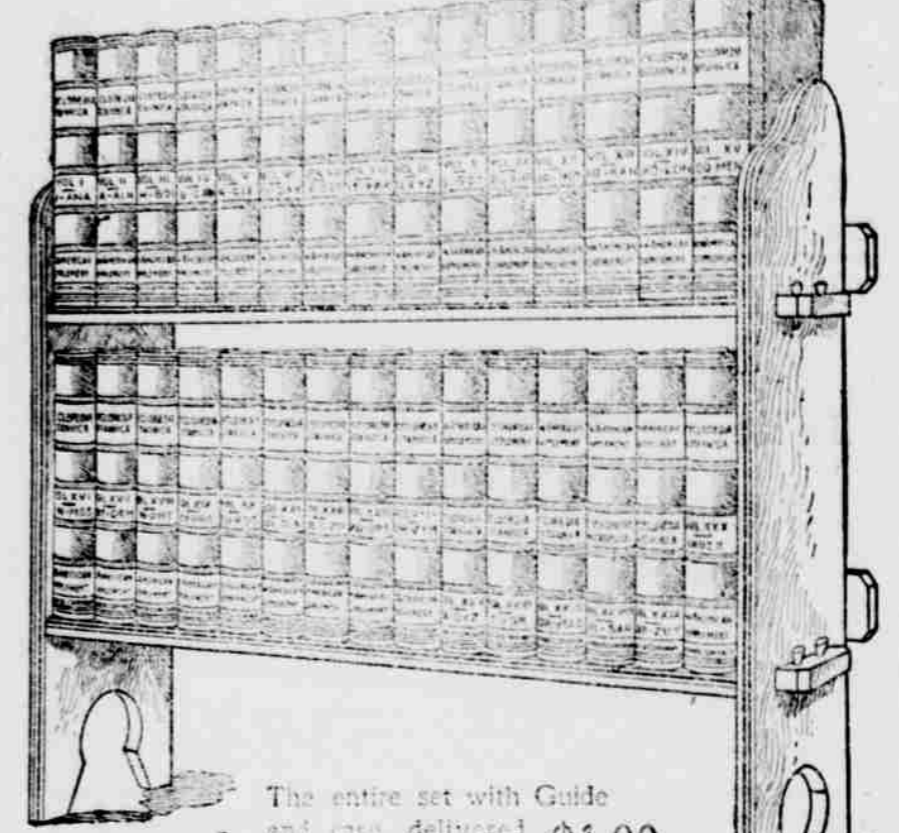
