barg, under Cieveland, caised him to devote much attention to the varied phases of the Boer war.
"I am inclined to believe," said Mr.
Tree, "that England Tree, "that England will impose no very
eevere condition on the Boers in the severe condition on the Boers in the
terme of peace. There dopa not geem to be any real feeling of bitterness against the Boers in England, and revenge will not be one of the motives to animate England in the settienent.
"England will undoubtediy insist on a full acknowledgement of her euzerainty,
and on a more liberal extension of the and on a more liberal extension of the
franchite and better representation for Uitlandere, so that they can have something to eay in the taxing power. Furtherwore, she will ineiat on the right to
have English taught, especiaily in thote have English taught, especiaily in thore echoole where a majority of the children
are of English parentuge," That these terme will be accepted by the Boere, and they will settle down quietly agsin after the war is over, Mr.
