Congressman Wilson, of Idaho, sends a long communication to the Lewiston Tribune telling what is being done by himself and others for the improvement of the Columbia river at the dalles. Mr. Wilson appeared before the river and harbor committee and urged the claims of a portage road in preference to any. the best. 


