Congressional Convention.

McMinnville, Or., April 10.—The first district congressional convention was called to order by R. J. Hendricks, chairman of the congressional committee. I. A. Macrum was made temporary chairman, and Hurlburt, of Lane, secretary.

After appointment of the usual committees the convention adjourned till 1 o'clock.

On the reassembling of the convention Thomas H. Tongue was reelected for congress on the first ballot.

The convention nominated as delegates to the national Republican convention: J. B. David, of Yamhill county, and Geo. A. Steel of Clackamas county.
