## Stock for Employes.

MINNEAPOLIS, May 9. - The Great Northern railroad, in accordance with its promise, has placed 10,000 shares of its stock on sale at par for its employes. The shares are to be handled by a new company, the Great Northern Employes' Investment Association, Ltd., managed by officials of the road. Employes purchasing stock will become members. No employe receiving \$3000 a year or over may buy stock, and none may hold more than \$5000 worth. Service of three years or more is prerequisite for purchasing employes. As the stock is worth \$155 a share, this action means a gift of over \$500,000 to its employes. There will be distributed in dividends on the stock \$70,000 a year.

## Wardner Investigation Closed.


