Since the water became clear a few salmon have escaped the gill nets and gotten up the river. Consequently, the seiners have been taking about enough fish to pay the expenses of operation.—Astoria News.
John Plummer and Isham Jeffries, while en route from Crook county to Ontario with a band of forty-five horses, purchased by them from E. A. Long, of Crook county, were arrested at Harney on complaint of B. F. Shepherd, who alleges that the horses were stolen.
After several years of waiting for some one to make a practical test for artesian water in Goose Lake valley, says the Lakeview Examiner, it has finally been made, and proven beyond a doubt that water can be found in this valley. Brad Lyons, of Willow Ranch, has made a successful test of artesian well boring, and now has a three-inch well sixty feet deep that throws a good stream of water five feet above the surface of the ground.
The burning of Lakeview made such a big blaze that it was observed for over 100 miles in several directions. Citizens of Klamath Falls, over 100 miles west of Lakeview, noticed the heavens illuminated and it was remarked at once that Lakeview must be burning. Silver Lake, 100 miles north, saw the fire, and it was thought to be Lakeview. Alturas, sixty miles south, and Cedarville, southeast, both saw our terrible fire.—Examiner.
