STILL MORE AMAZING IMPU-DENCE.

The Times-Mountaineer is welcome to all the capital it can make out of the deportation of Mullet and "Skin the Goat." Eighteen years ago, when these men were convicted of conspiracy in the murder of T. H. Burke and Lord Frederick Cavendish, the leaders of the national party in Ireland, Messrs. Mullet and Fitzharris were not condemned to a life servitude merely as suspects, as our contemporary would have it, but for actual and well attested conspiracy in the crime of murder. 
