CAMPAIGN TAKES A NEW TURN

Robert's Army Has Left Pretoria and Johannesburg Under Strong Guard and is Now Advancing on President Kruger's Stronghold.

NEW YORK, July 26 .- A dispatch to the Tribune from London says: The campaign in South Africa has taken an unexpected turn. Lord Roberts' army has advanced to Bronkhorst Spruit, about half way between Pretoria and Middleburg. He is leaving Pretoria and Johannesburg under a strong guard, and acting on the theory that the Boers profit by his halts and lose whenever his columns are in motion. The Boers have attempted to thwart his plane by raide west and north of Pretoria, and to hold him back by hanging on his flanks, just as they did when he set out from Bloemfontein to Pretoria.
