"Of the whole eight weeks of terrible anxiety and dread," said Miss Payne, "three nights stand out with special prominence. They are spoken of by the besieged as 'the three terrible nights.' "The second terrible night was about the middle of the siege, when, after three or four days of muggy, sultry weather, one of the most violent thunder storm I ever experienced broke over the city. It was a night of bellowing thunder, roaring artillery, inceseant lightning and pouring rain.

China Will Punish Boxer Leaders,

Washington, Oct. 2.-The Chinese minister has delivered to the state department official confirmation of the degradation of Prince Tuan and many other Chinese leaders. The following official statement is made as to Minister Wu's dispatch :
