CLEVELAND, O., Oct. 25.—The Iron Trade Review this week says: "With the election so close at hand, it might be assumed that buying of iron and steel would wait on the actual announcement of the result. As a matter of fact, there has been an active market in the past week, finished material being in largest demand, while pig-iron in some selling centers has been more active than in recent weeks.

The placing of contracts with the proviso that they be canceled in case the result is unfavorable to business, or, more specifically, is against the administration, has been a feature of the week's business. Many buyers, also, satisfied of the election outcome, are evidently placing their orders in the belief that demand will increase promptly on the announcement of the result, and that the result, on some materials, at least, will be higher prices.
