### THE DALLES VICTORIOUS.

A Closely Contested Game But The Dalles Won By a Score of 6 to 5.

The much-heralded football game between Washington Agricultural College, of Pullman, and The Dalles Football Association eleven, was pulled off yesterday on time at the latter's grounds near the Wasco warehouse. The game was one of full thirty-five minute halves, full of brilliant plays, both offensive and defensive. The Dalles team can feel that they now take an important place in the football field, for the Pullman boys had not been scored against this season until yesterday's game.

Lawrence, right-half for Pullman, was a hard one for The Dalles boys to solve, and their line backs difficult to meet. The visitors showed organization and hard training, so essential in football work. Individually, The Dalles made the most brilliant plays, the most important being Cooper's kangaroo leaps, Frizzell's pretty catch and big run, the solid work of all the backs, supported by Captain Bartell, and the good work of ends and line. It was noticeable, however, that The Dalles boys were not in the physical condition that marked the successes of the Pullman team, a defect that should be corrected, and which is wholly in their power to do.

Morally and socially, Washington Agricultural College should be proud of the young men who were sent to meet our boys. They are a body of born gentlemen, and it is regrettable that their visit to our midst could not have been prolonged. To the credit of all Dalles people, the young men met with a general and hearty reception, leaving last evening for their school right well pleased with their treatment and happy withal, though they had suffered defeat by one point.

In the game, Pullman won the toss-up and took choice of position, the east goal, giving The Dalles the kick-off. The half was remarkable for the even playing, and at no time was either goal in danger.

In the second half the defensive playing of both teams was not so good as in the first, and in ten minutes after the kick-off Pullman had the pigskin over the line; but in punting back for position to kick goal lost the chance by making a bad catch, the ball touching the ground. The remainder of the game was The Dalles' the home team making a touchdown through their redoubtable captain Max Bartell, following it with a punt for position and a successful goal kick by McKenzie, the splendid quarterback. At the close of the game Pullman had the ball, but were making no great gains.

The game was entirely free from "rag-chewing," loud talking and slugging. "Fatty" Brown, who has always held the position of center in The Dalles

team, played "good guard" yesterday, Earle taking center. "Fat" is an all-round football enthusiast.
