The Wheat Trade.

Very few wheat transfers were made last week, and from appearances no important trades are likely to be made in the immediate future. Heavy stocks are warehoused here by each exporting firm, and they have about all the grain they care to carry, unless sellers show a disposition to accept market values. Most of the wheat on hand is largely held against future needs of tonnage chartered ahead, and which must be given prompt dispatch when at hand. Few sellers are in the market at present prices, desirable parcels of good shipping quality being firmly held at comparatively stiff figures. Walla Walla wheat is coming in freely, mostly of purchases made some time ago.

Appearance indicate that holders have more confidence in a future enhancement of values, and consequently are more reluctantly to offer their grain. If interior holders are under the impression that exporters are in need of grain on account of the fancy prices recently paid, they had better be set at rights at once. They need not make any mistake about shippers being

pressed for grain. Vessels are receiving very quick dispatch, and as soon as berths on docks are vacant other ships take their places. The cargo market since our last review has declined 6d per quarter, and prevailing rates offered are very extreme limits.—Portland Commercial Review.
