The Heppner line-up for the battle of next Friday and respective weights are as follows: Matlock, c, 170; Beal, rg, 168; Saling, lg, 160; Anderson, rt, 170; Leland, lt, 176; Ball, le, 160; Bisbee, re, 140; Spaulding, qb, 134; Clarke (captain), lb, 165; Spaulding, rh, 160; Young, fb, 155. The average is placed at 150, which are the figures of the Heppner athletes. The estimate is fully thirteen pounds "shy."

The line-up of the Dalles team will appear in tomorrow's issue. Their average is about 163 pounds.
