Havana, Jan. 3.-The Cuban conatita. ional convention is considering two pro-
mulgations of the future reiationa between Cuba and the United Statee. On of thete affirms, in the first place, an ache establishment of friendlv relations ith all nations, xogether with a resoiu. ceord with United States. cond place, it proposes to put at the limposal of the United states a portion of the shore of any bay of the north or naval stations, together with conpeasions eufficient in extent for the purthird place, it deciaree that Cuba will place herneff on a war footing, to heip
the United States in case such assistance houid be needed, while a fourth provieo is an amplification of the first, second and third.
"Firet-Themulgation contempiates "Firat-That the convention ie vested egisiative functione, the eouvention can not arrange the basis of future relatione Third-Nevertheiess, should Waeh iagtou desire such a discussion, the conenion ie wiling to diacenes and agree apon an arrangeneat mutnal rela
