

SCHOOL NOTES.

News Items that Will Be of Interest to the Friends of Wasco County's Public Schools.

The District Boundary Board is composed of the three members of the county court, with the county judge as chairman and county school superintendent as secretary.

Petition to divide school district No. 27, near Dufur, signed by twenty-four petitioners and filed Nov. 12, 1900.

The legal voters of school district No. 49, or Bake Oven district, petition to have the eastern portion of said district created into a new district to accommodate the children residing in and about Shaniko.

The homesteaders and others living in the western portion of school district No. 42, Wamoc, ask that the western part of said district constitute a new district.

A petition from school district No. 30 and one from school district No. 21 prays that the S<sub>1/2</sub> of S<sub>1/2</sub> of Sec. 16, W<sub>1/2</sub> of N<sub>1/2</sub>, NE<sub>1/4</sub> of N<sub>1/2</sub>, NW<sub>1/4</sub> of NE<sub>1/4</sub> of Sec. 21, T. 1 S., R. 14 E. be set out of school district No. 30 and included within the boundary lines of school district No. 21.

Oregon is now divided into two parts for the purpose of holding state teachers' associations. The Cascade mountains being the dividing line between the eastern division and western division leaves Wasco county nearer the latter, although included within the limits of the former.

The Dalles schools will resume work next Monday after two weeks holiday vacation. Hood River and Antelope schools began again last Wednesday.

School assembled at Dufur on Monday, Dec. 31st, in the principal's room, and rendered an interesting program of vocal and instrumental music, readings and recitations.
