bett again came up for the ssme oftice in 1897．A caucus was beld Mitchell．There was no possible way to defeat Mr．Mitcbell except
by induciug a minority of the re－ pyblicans and a sufficient number of populists and democrats to refase to take the oath of office and orgas－ oughly anarcbistic and revolutionary measure Corbett＇s Priends committed
themselves．Some eighteen populist members，by the confession of their leader，U＇Ren of Clacksmas，were bought up like so many sheep． Money flowed like water．The bead－ quarters of the opposition to Mr． Hichell berame a hell of debaucb ery．The hold．up succeeded and Corbett reaped the usufruct in an appointment by the governor which States senate
