

If the Philippines be considered "part of the United States," and coming under the constitutional provision that "all duties, imposts and excises shall be uniform throughout the United States," there would at once be precipitated, in consequence of this doctrine, the same kind of a violation of the constitution as is now charged up against the doctrine that the Philippines are owned by the United States and are not a "part" thereof.

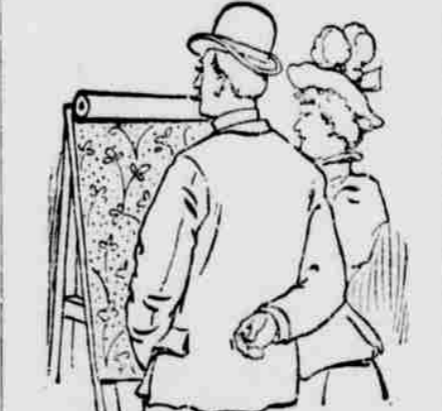
