**Cattlemen's Association.**

DENVER, Feb. 26.—There is much speculation in the livestock world as to the action which will be taken by the American Cattle Growers' Association regarding the National Livestock Association. It has been understood in some quarters that the new association which is to hold its first convention in Denver, March 5, will become a member of the older organization, but many claim that it will not only hold aloof, but draw all the cattlemen away from the livestock association.

The executive committee of the Cattle Growers' Association will meet in Denver, March 4, to lay out the work of the convention. The questions to be considered will include those of the government land leasing, transportation rates and privileges, inspection fees and others of almost equal importance.

The secretary of the American Cattle Growers' Association has given out the statement that the present membership, which includes many of the most prominent cattle-growers in the country, from North Dakota to Arizona, and from the Missouri river to the Pacific Coast, represents cattle to the value of \$150,000,000.
