Council Meeting.

The regular monthly meeting of the city council was held last night at the council chambers. All the members were present except the mayor, in whose absence Councilman Gunning presided.

A petition was presented by Al Bettingen, agent, asking that he be paid \$200 damages on account of his building having been quarantined by the city when a case of smallpox broke out in the building. The matter was referred to a select committee consisting of Councilmen Shackelford, Keller and Wakefield.

The judiciary committee reported that the case of Paul Kruger against Dalles City for damages for injuries received through an alleged defective sidewalk had been continued till the May term of circuit court.

E. O. McCoy, representing a company that proposes to incorporate the present Electric Light Company and the Wasco Warehouse Company, including the new flouring mill, under one management, and bring their power from Hood river, appeared before the council and asked that the company which he represented be granted the privilege of submitting an offer for lighting the streets of the city before a contract had been closed with any other company. Further action on the matter of lighting the street was deferred and the recorder was instructed meanwhile to draw up specifications for a light system upon which intending contractors may base their bids.

A number of bills for supplies furnished the smallpox patient who occupied the Bettingen building were referred to the special committee appointed to consider the Bettingen claim.

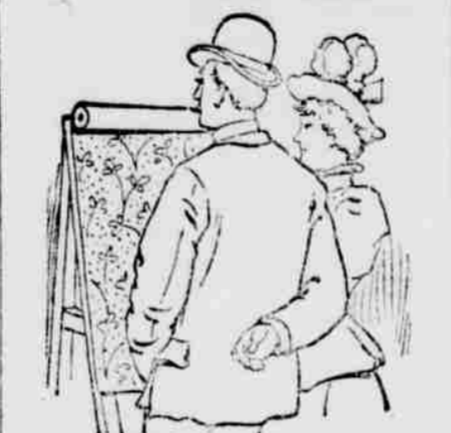
